Under Sutton's leadership, a 4-plex was purchased in February 2011 that provides emergency shelter to families, and a backpack program delivers food to school-aged children on weekends during the school year. Starting November 1, Our Neighbors' Place will provide overnight shelter for single adults. The shelter will open evenings at 7:45 p.m. with doors closing at 9 p.m.

Sutton believes that "we are our neighbor's keeper and are here to help others, with compassion and without judgment". Founded on this principle, Our Neighbors' Place is safe haven for those who need a stepping stone to a better life – an opportunity to become independent and self-sufficient.

Author Matthew Kelley encourages each of us to become the "best-version-of-oneself", something Sutton works hard to accomplish every day. She hopes the same for those touched by Our Neighbors' Place, one day at a time.
